Apostolic Age - Beginning on Pentecost in 30 AD and <u>ending</u> in 100 AD at the death of the Apostle John.

The gifts of miracles and healing and tongues and interpretations of tongues/languages were 4 sign gifts given to the Apostles and their close associates.

These gifts were no longer needed at the <u>completion</u> of the NT.

Before the completion of the Bible miraculous gifts were given to men to <u>accredit</u> the Message proclaimed and them as True Messengers.

John 3:2 "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

Acts 3:1-10 NASB

Being <u>poor</u> and not having a great paying job and struggling to make ends meet <u>does not</u> mean that God does not love you or you are doing something wrong or you do not have enough faith.

There are much more important things to have than money.

It is a foretaste of heaven not the <u>norm</u> for earth. It's a verifiable miracle healing.

Acts 3:11-26 Peter preaches his 2nd sermon.

The faith Peter was talking about was <u>their</u> faith in Jesus Christ to heal the man. Not the man's faith. Faith healers blame your lack of faith.

Does God do miracle's today, <u>yes.</u> But what is a miracle? A miracle is a supernatural event which has no human explanation. A miracle is a supernatural event which suspends natural law.

Providence is when God is simply orchestrating <u>natural</u> events; not suspending the natural but controlling the natural so that it does what He wants it to do.
